

Protocols for Athletic Facilities for Spring Sporting Events

General Information for all spring athletic events:

- Masks should be worn at all times when moving. If socially distanced, masks may be removed when seated.
- All spectators should remain home if they have a fever, feel sick, or are showing COVID-19 symptoms.
- All spectators must stay home and quarantine if they have had close contact with a person who has symptoms of COVID-19 within the past fourteen days.
- If you are 65 years of age or older or have underlying health conditions, including high blood pressure, chronic lung disease, diabetes, severe obesity, asthma, or weakened immunity, you may wish to refrain from entering the facilities.
- Seating for spectators will be limited and certain seats will not be available in order to maintain the appropriate distance from other spectators.
- Temperature checks may be taken for all spectators before entering an event.
- Any noise makers that could potentially spread respiratory droplets are prohibited at any event.
- Hand sanitizer will be available at all events.

Signage at Events:

- Signs will be posted that all spectators must wear masks when moving.
- Signs will be posted for everyone to maintain the appropriate social distance of at least six feet from others.

Capacity of Facility:

- The baseball stadium will have a maximum capacity of 200 spectators.
 - 150 tickets for home fans
 - 50 tickets for visiting fans
- The softball stadium will have a maximum capacity of 200 spectators.
 - 150 tickets for home fans
 - 50 tickets for visiting fans
- The track for our Track Team will have a maximum capacity of 250 spectators.
- The maximum number of spectators for golf will follow guidelines from the City of Dillon Municipal Golf Course.

Ticket Sales:

- Tickets should be purchased prior to all events.
- Home fans with Gold Passes will be honored as long as space permits.
- High School League passes will be honored as long as space permits (may have to stand if seats are not available).
- The families of players will have first priority.
 - Each player will have an opportunity to purchase up to six tickets per event.
 - Any remaining tickets will be purchased on a first come first served basis.
- The spectators for the visiting team will also need to purchase tickets prior to an event.
 - 50 tickets for visiting fans will be available for baseball games.

- 50 tickets for visiting fans will be available for softball games.
- A fee is not charged for Track, but the head coach will contact the visiting team to determine how many family members and/or fans will be in attendance in order to maintain the designated capacity for the event.
- Head coaches will reach out to the visiting team prior to the event to determine the number of tickets requested.
- No team members from other sports will be allowed in an event without a ticket.
- Faculty / Staff will also have to have a ticket to attend an event unless they are working at the event.

Facility Seating:

- Only family members should sit together at an event.
- Fans should distance themselves to allow for the appropriate six feet distance between spectators or family groups in the home and visitor stands.
- Seats in each facility will be available to families on a first come first served basis.

Baseball / Softball Stadium (Additional Protocols):

- An officer or staff member will be positioned at the entrance to the stadium to take up tickets for the baseball/softball games.
 - Tickets will be taken up from spectators in their cars as they enter the parking area.
 - A stamp will be placed on each person's hand to signify they entered the parking area with a ticket.
 - This will allow people to park in approved sections outside the fenced area of the field and remain in their vehicles.
 - These spectators may also choose to sit in front of their vehicles in folding chairs but should maintain the appropriate distance from other vehicles.
- Home spectators and visiting spectators will sit in their designated areas.
- The area outside the restrooms will be marked to help spectators keep the appropriate distance while waiting.
- No spectators will be allowed to gather on the field after the game.
- The teams will not have their normal team handshakes after the game.
- Spectators may be dismissed by sections to avoid too many exiting the stadium at one time.
- Spectators should not gather outside the bathroom area or in any area of the stadium.
- Fans from the home team should never go to the visitor's stands.
- Fans from the visiting school should remain on their side of the stands unless using the restrooms.
- There will be a designated area for parents to pick-up players after the game.

Concessions at Baseball / Softball Games:

- Only prepackaged food items will be available.
- Fans will be encouraged to have the correct change when paying for concession items.

- The area outside the concession stand will be marked to indicate the appropriate six feet distance between spectators.
- Concession stand counters will be cleaned frequently.
- Hand sanitizer will be available at the concession stand.
- Sneeze guard barriers will be used at the concession stand.
- Gloves will be worn by concession workers.

Track - (Additional Protocols):

- Spectators should maintain six feet spacing between families throughout the event.
- No gathering should occur in any area.

Golf – (Additional Protocols):

- Spectators will maintain six feet spacing between families throughout the event.
- No gathering should occur in any area.
