SCHOOL PROPERTIES DISPOSITION

Code DN Issued 8/04

Purpose: To establish the basic structure for disposal of property that is no longer needed.

The board may sell or lease school property, real or personal, whenever such property is no longer needed for school purposes. The district will apply proceeds of any such sale or lease to the general funds of the district.

Under certain circumstances, the board will obtain the consent of the county board before making such sale or lease.

The state board of education must approve, in advance and in writing, the reassignment or disposal of parcels of land purchased after 1952 with any state funds.

The district must follow any other State Department of Education Office of District Facilities Management regulations regarding disposal of property.
