STUDENT INSURANCE COVERAGE

Code JLA Issued 6/05

Purpose: To establish the basic structure for the provision of and requirements for student insurance coverage.

The district makes available information regarding a low-cost accident insurance program for students. At a minimum, the insurance may provide accident coverage for students on the way to and from school, while at school and whenever they are engaging in school-sponsored activities.

The district requires that all students participating in the following activities have accident insurance.

- all middle school athletics
- interscholastic athletics on the varsity and junior varsity level and B teams
- intramural football
- high school band
- high school physical education
- vocational laboratory courses
- other offerings and courses as determined by the principal/director

The district will not require those students, other than those participating in interscholastic athletics on the varsity, junior varsity and middle school levels, to purchase accident insurance if the student provides documentation from the parent/legal guardian stating that the student has other adequate insurance coverage and does not wish to participate in the accident insurance plan made available by the district.
