Minutes

March 12, 2024

The Latta School Board of Trustees met for the regular monthly meeting on Tuesday, March 12, 2024 at 6:00 p.m. in the Latta Elementary School library. In accordance with S.C. Code of Laws of 1976, as amended, Section 30-4-80(E). *The Dillon Herald* was notified of the time, date, place and agenda of this meeting.
