BOARD MEMBER COMPENSATION AND EXPENSES

Code BID Issued 8/04

Purpose: To establish the basic structure for payment of board expenses.

Board members receive no compensation for their services.

The board may attend any meeting or conference at their discretion within the limits of the budget and with the approval of the board.

The district will reimburse board members for all reasonable and necessary expenses incurred in attending any meeting or conference when on official business of the board or the school district.

In the event of considerable expected travel expense, a majority of the board will designate how many may attend at district expense. In the event that more wish to attend than is designated, the board may have the option of setting a limit on total expenditures and dividing this equally so that more may attend partially at their own expense.
