EQUAL EDUCATION OPPORTUNITY/ NONDISCRIMINATION

Code JB Issued 9/10

Purpose: To establish the board's vision regarding equal educational opportunities for all students in the district.

The board believes that the district must provide public education in an atmosphere where differences are understood and appreciated. The district will treat all persons fairly, with respect and without discrimination.

Every student of this school district will be offered equal educational opportunities regardless of ethnic or racial background, religious beliefs, sex, disability, immigrant status or English speaking status, and economic or social conditions. The district will not refuse to admit or exclude any person based on these criteria. The district will advertise this nondiscrimination policy.

The superintendent is responsible for ensuring that procedures are in place to support this policy. Each principal is responsible for working with the staff and students in his/her school to ensure equal opportunity for all students.
